### Street Smarts


- Never run into the street.

- The bus driver is not able to see anything in this area. The Danger Zone is
- >right in front of the bus and the area all around the rear wheels and the back of the bus.

### Waiting for the Bus

- ➤ Be at the bus stop 5 minutes early.
- Stay away from the curb.
- ➤ Be quiet while you wait for the bus.
- >Don't get on the bus until it stops.
- >Don't push getting on or off the bus.
